The Junior League of Texarkana, Inc. is an organization of women committed to promoting voluntarism, developing the potential of women and improving communities through the effective action and leadership of trained volunteers. Its purpose is exclusively education and charitable.

WHAT IS EXPECTED OF NEW MEMBERS?

Financial Obligations

New Members are responsible for the following financial obligations:

1. New Member dues in the amount of \$150.00
2. Mistletoe Fair quota in the amount of \$150.00
 - * *It is preferred that this amount is fulfilled through selling various tickets for Mistletoe Fair events, but it may also be paid directly to the League. Regardless, ALL members are responsible for \$150.00.*
3. Actively support fundraising projects adopted by JLT Membership
4. New Member class t-shirt, if agreed on by the class, in the amount of \$10.00 - \$15.00

Course Requirements

In addition to attending monthly New Member Education sessions and General Meetings, New Members are responsible for the following:

1. In-League training – Each New Member will attend a JLT Board of Directors meeting, Mistletoe Fair Committee meeting, and local city council or school board meeting. The New Member class will also visit additional JLT committee meetings and events as deemed necessary by the New Member Education co-chairs. Through these experiences, New Members will learn about League placements, placement duties, and the community. In-League training provides a comprehensive look at League operations and equips New Members to be contributing members of the organization.
2. Required shifts – JLT's fundraising project, Mistletoe Fair, supports the League's Mission. New Members are required to work additional fundraising shifts in order to receive the training necessary to understand the League's financial operations. New Members are also required to work shifts in support of community projects.

New Members will work:

- ✓ Two (2) 3-hour Mistletoe Fair pre-shifts
 - * *These are typically scheduled during the summer and fall months leading up to the event.*
 - ✓ Two (2) 4-hour Mistletoe Fair shifts (Friday-Sunday during the event)
 - ✓ Two (2) League-developed (community) project shifts (2 hour minimum)
 - ✓ *These include Open Hearts Food Pantry, Packs for a Purpose, Shoes for the Soul & Clothes for a Cause, and Spring Into Reading.*
3. New Member Party and Retreat – The outgoing New Member class plans and hosts a party for the incoming New Member class each the spring. Each New Member is required to attend the incoming and outgoing parties and the New Member retreat held in the summer.

Absences

The Junior League of Texarkana values your participation in all New Member course requirements. Completion of the course provides comprehensive leadership training. It is important that you attend all events.

No more than THREE absences will be allowed during the League year. New members who exceed the number of allowed absences will be required to repeat the course with the next year's class.

Approval for absences and make-up activities are at the discretion of the New Member co-chairs.

- E. Fulfill additional requirements as determined by the New Member Education co-chairs.
- F. Maintain regular attendance.
 - * *No more than three (3) absences will be allowed during the League year. New members who exceed the number of allowed absences will be required to repeat the course with next year's class.*
